REVISION OF AGE LIMITS FOR 2024

To align to global FIM Hard Enduro and Enduro events, the age limit for Competitors meeting Qualifying criteria has been revised to 14 Years of Age at time of participation.

These criteria ensure the safety and preparedness of young riders participating in the Roof of Africa event and are designed to ensure that Qualifying youths have a proven track record of their ability to deal with the mental, emotional, physical and technical abilities required to successfully complete a Roof of Africa: All supporting documentation to be mailed to <u>entries@theroofofafrica.com</u>

- 1. Medical Clearance: A thorough medical examination to ensure that the young rider is physically and mentally fit to compete in such a demanding race.
- 2. Recommendation Letters: Letters of recommendation from coaches, mentors, or experienced riders who can vouch for the competitor's skill level and readiness for the race.
- 3. Age Verification: Documentation proving the rider's age, as eligibility is strictly tied to being 14 years old during the current year of the race.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA: All supporting documentation to be mailed to <u>entries@theroofofafrica.com</u>

All Riders must be a Current National High School Class Competitors actively competing in the National Enduro / National Hard Enduro Championship.

IRON CLASS:

Rider must be a Current National High School Class Competitor actively competing in the National Enduro Championship.
 The rider must have completed at minimum a Bronze Class Impi Hard Enduro.





BRONZE CLASS:

Rider must be a Current National High School Class Competitor actively competing in the National Enduro Championship. The rider must have completed at minimum a Bronze Class Impi Hard Enduro. The rider must have completed a Bronze National HESA Hard Enduro.

SILVER AND GOLD CLASS:

Silver and Gold class entries are merit based and on invitation only.

Rider must be a Current National High School Class Competitor actively competing in the National Enduro Championship. Rider must have completed a Gold Class Impi Hard Enduro.

Rider must have completed a Silver or Gold National HESA Hard Enduro.

Rider requires 3 letters of recommendation from coaches, mentors, or experienced riders who can vouch for the competitor's skill level and readiness for the race.

The Motul Roof of Africa competitors need to hold a valid MSA (minimum of) One Event Cross Country Motorcycle / Enduro Club Licence, except for foreign competitors – see below.

Foreign competitors (Non-RSA / Non-Lesotho Residents) need to hold a FIM licence valid for the event, as well as a starting permission from their home National Motorsport Federation (FMN). A copy of the competitor's passport is also required to be forwarded. This letter, passport and FIM Licence copy must be sent to the organisers and MSA (Carmen Hill – carmen@motorsport.co.za)

No licenses or insurance cover will be available at documentation.

6. INJURY REGISTER

Where a competitor has appeared on the injury register, it is that competitor's responsibility to ensure that they have submitted a medical certificate indicating that they are fit to compete in motorsport no later than 5 (five) working days before the start of the event. This certificate is to be reviewed and processed by MSA Head Office.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to check the Injury Register and ensure that MSA receives their letter timeously. Please Note: Competing while appearing on the injury register will result in potential claims being repudiated by the MSA Group Accident Policy.

The riding of Pit Bikes, Motor Bikes and Bicycles in the pits, other than by competitors is not permitted.

The purpose of the Event is to test the reliability of the motorcycles and the skill of the participating competitor as a combined unit. Where the combined unit, does not traverse the entire route, a penalty of 30 minutes plus time for the advantage gained will be applied at the discretion of the COC.

Pit crew refers to all persons who support a rider e.g., the riders mechanical crew, his family, friends and sponsor and/or entrant, this list is not complete.

INSURANCE:

The organisers pay a levy on behalf of the competitors and officials, towards a Public Liability Policy which is held through MSA.
