MSA NORTHERN REGIONS CROSS COUNTRY MOTORCYCLE & QUAD CIRCULAR 01 OF 2024

Affected parties should note that following the cancellation of Round 4 of the 2024 MSA Northern Regions Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad Championship – Senior Mcycle classes, due to unforeseen circumstances, the following will apply with immediate effect:

- Round 4 will not be rescheduled, however, based on the below process, it will still be retained for scoring in the 2024 Northern Regions Regional Senior and Junior Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad Championship.
- 2. The points which are normally available for each class per round, from 1st place to 20th place for the Regional Championship, are as follows:

1 st – 25 points	11 th – 10 points	
2 nd – 22 points	12 th – 9 points	
3 rd – 20 points	13 th – 8 points	
4 th – 18 points	14 th – 7 points	
5 th – 16 points	15 th – 6 points	
6 th – 15 points	16 th – 5 points	
7 th – 14 points	17 th – 4 points	
8 th – 13 points	18 th – 3 points	
9 th – 12 points	19 th – 2 points	
10 th – 11 points	20 th – 1 points	

- 3. In each of the **remaining** rounds of the Championship, a competitor will earn the points for that specific round in accordance with his/her finishing position of that round <u>plus</u> a quarter of the same position's points, which will be allocated to Round 4.
- 4. Below is an example of how points can be accumulated by a competitor for Round 4 based on his/her finishing positions in each of the remaining rounds of the Championship:

- 6. The one "throw-away" race for the season will still apply. A competitor must drop his/her lowest points for the season, provided that the competitor started the race.
- 7. Therefore, if Round 4 is a competitor's lowest points scoring race of the Championship, those points may be dropped.
- 8. The above point scoring system for the remainder of the Championship will only apply to competitors who entered for Round 4, paid their full entry fee and had a valid MSA license to compete in Round 4. If all of these provisions are met, the competitor will be considered a starter for Round 4.
- 9. Competitors who withdrew from Round 4 before the start of the event will not be considered as a starter for Round 4 and will not score any points for the said event.
- 10. Please refer to SSR 21 b) of the 2024 NR Snr & Jnr Motorcycles & Quads SSRs regarding refund of entry fees.
- 11. Trophies & medals for Round 4 for the senior classes will be awarded to competitors after the podium places have been determined at the completion of the Championship (after Round 8). Junior & quad prize giving for Round 4 will take place at Round 5.
