## **5. ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS**

#### 6. INJURY REGISTER

Where a competitor has appeared on the injury register, it is that competitor's responsibility to ensure that they have submitted a medical certificate indicating that they are fit to compete in motorsport no later than 5 (five) working days before the start of the event. This certificate is to be reviewed and processed by MSA Head Office.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to check the Injury Register and ensure that MSA receives their letter timeously.

Please Note: Competing while appearing on the injury register will result in potential claims being repudiated by the MSA Group Accident Policy.

### 7. COMPETITOR CONDUCT

The riding of pit bikes, motorbikes and bicycles in the pits, other than by competitors is not permitted.

The purpose of the Event is to test the reliability of the motorcycles and the skill of the participating competitor as a combined unit. Where the combined unit, does not traverse the entire route, a penalty of 30 minutes plus time for the advantage gained will be applied at the discretion of the COC.

Pit crew refers to all persons who support a rider e.g., the riders mechanical crew, his family, friends and sponsor and/or Entrant, this list is not complete.

#### **INSURANCE:**

The organisers pay a levy on behalf of the competitors and officials, towards a Public Liability Policy which is held through MSA.

## **16. MX VS ENDURO CHALLENGE**

The MX vs Enduro challenge is a fun challenge to bring all offroad racing facets together in a fun event.

- The Jnr MX vs Enduro class and the Snr MX vs Enduro class will be separate social classes from the normal GXCC junior, quad & senior bikes social classes.
- Enduro competitors with an existing MSA license may use such license for this event.
- MX competitors may either upgrade their MX licenses or use a cross country social license, provided that they are on their own medical aid.
- Entry fees for the MX vs Enduro classes will be R550 (which includes a social license)
- All junior MX & Enduro competitors will start and race together.
- All senior MX & Enduro competitors will start and race together.
- Juniors will start at **08:00** and race on the junior route (loop appr. 16km) for 2 hours.
- Seniors will start at 12:00 and race on the senior route (loop appr. 50km) for 3 hours.
- Points will be awarded to the first 20 competitors in each MX vs Enduro class as per GXCC SSR 12.
- The total amount of points scored by jnr & snr MX competitors and the total amount of points scored by jnr & snr Enduro competitors will be tallied together at the end of the event and an overall facet winner will be declared.
- Bike and age specifications must be in accordance with GXCC SSR's.
- All rules in respect of cross country racing will be applicable.

- Report to Documentation on arrival and sign on the Media Attendance Register which will be submitted to MSA after the event. and:
- Obtain permission from the Clerk of the Course to go out on the track / route during the event.
