## REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS

ANY proposed / desired changes to these Championship Regulations must be submitted to the Controllers for approval. The Controllers reserve the right to introduce new Regulations and / or amend existing Regulations with the approval of Motorsport South Africa (MSA).

Amendments and updates to the rules will be recorded in the Amendment Record, detailing the updated version, date of approval of the amendment and a short summary of the amendment. The new version of the rules will be published by MSA at least seven (7) days prior to the next event being held unless a shorter notice period is approved by MSA.

All race meetings shall be held under the 2025 MSA General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Club Regulations, the event Supplementary Regulations (SR's) and any applicable Circulars of MSA for Enduro. In the event that the Club Rules are silent, the National Rules shall, at all times prevail.

**2. ELIGIBILITY OF RIDERS**

- 2.1 All competitors must hold a valid MSA competition licence for Cross Country Mcycles & Quads / Enduro
- 2.2 Only **PAID UP** CSMX club members will score points in this championship.
- 2.3 Non CSMX members and leisure licence holders will be removed from results when scoring club classes.

**3. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

The CSMX Club Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the **2025** Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- Silver
- Highschool
- Ladies
- Pro 85
- 85cc Junior
- 65cc
- Ladies Intro

<b>85cc Junior</b>	Open to competitors from the year of their 7 <sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 <sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their <b>13<sup>th</sup></b> birthday occurs. <b>Please note that the age for female competitor will be from the year of the competitor's 7<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.</b> <i>90mins follow the JUNIOR Loop</i>	The maximum permissible capacity is 85cc 2-stroke cooled or 150cc 4-stroke.
<b>65cc</b>	Open to competitors from the year of their 7 <sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31 <sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their <b>13<sup>th</sup></b> birthday occurs. <b>Please note that the age for female competitor will be from the year of the competitor's 7<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs.</b> <i>90mins follow the JUNIOR Loop</i>	The maximum permissible capacity is 65cc 2-stroke or 85cc auto or 110cc 4-stroke.
<b>Ladies Intro</b>	From the year of the competitors <b>13<sup>th</sup></b> birthday and older <i>90mins follow the JUNIOR Loop</i>	Restricted capacity as per Pro 85, High School, E1 & E2
<b>Social</b>	From the year of the competitors <b>13<sup>th</sup></b> birthday. <b>This is a non-championship class and requires a minimum of a Social Motorcycle Cross Country / Enduro / Quad licence.</b> <i>2hrs follow the SILVER Loop</i>	Restricted capacity as per High School, E1 & E2

4.2 Only 1 club class may be entered, ***with the exception of our Ladies riders, who are allowed to compete in both the Ladies and a Club/Regional class.***

4.3 For overall position on the Gold loop, riders will be scored on most laps first and then best times, regardless of whether they are riding in the 3 or 2 hour class (2 hour competitors must stop once given the chequered flag).

## 7. START ORDER

The starting order is determined by overall position. The club runs an overall across all classes, including the Gold loop (E1, E2, Senior, and Master), Highschool, Silver, Pro 85, Social, and the Junior loop (85cc Jnr, 65cc and Ladies Intro) to establish the start order. NEW riders in each class will be positioned at the back, based on their bike number. However, organisers may move riders forward at their discretion.

## 8. CLASSES WINNERS AWARDS

8.1 Minimum of 3 competitors per class to announce class winners.

8.2 If less than 3 on average over the CSMX racing season are received, we will not award a champion.

## 9. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have "officially" assisted will be kept by the club

## 11. OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE

Although it is recommended that all **JUNIOR competitors 65cc, 85cc JNR, Pro 85 & Ladies Intro** be capable of handling the motorcycle without assistance, it is noted that due to the difficulty of the terrain crossed, and ridden, and in the interest of growing our future riders, assistance by signed on officials & marshals is allowed **for 65cc, 85cc JNR, Pro 85 & Ladies Intro only**, provided the rider is unable to get through an obstacle, or is trapped. There will be no chaperoning allowed.
