Participants need to choose a class.

If a participant chooses to enter Gold, he/she will start in the Gold class in order of time trial results.

If a participant is unable to complete Gold, he/she will be downgraded to the class he/she completed for the next day. The participant will start at the back of that class, with a 1 hour time penalty.

The same will apply for a participant that has entered Silver, and has to downgrade during the event.

The participant will start the next day at the back of the class he/she completed, with a 1 hour time penalty. This applies to all the classes.

A participant can choose to upgrade while riding. eg: if a participant entered Bronze, he/she can choose to ride Silver and Gold while on the track. A participant will start in the class that he/she completed the previous day. All participants under 16 need a chaperone.

A chaperone will have to pay their own entry fee and needs a minimum of a Social licence.
